


What's New?

 - Preliminary proposal required for CREST Centers (including Phase II)
 - ease proposal preparation burden;
 - increase proposal quality.
- Full Proposals
 - Full CREST Center proposals may be submitted <u>by</u> <u>invitation only</u> after the review of the preliminary proposal is completed.

Partnership Supplements

Collaborations - involving industry, other research universities, federally funded labs, K-12 entities including museums and science centers, or other national, state or regional research and development institutions.

- underlying issues affecting the differential participation and success rates of students from underrepresented groups;
- add to the research knowledge base;
